

NISSAN REPAIR CONSIDERATIONS

NI002E01

This one-hour online course provides an overview of Nissan's repair considerations. The course familiarizes the technician with the vehicles that make up the Nissan model lineup. Additionally, it looks at how to access the repair procedures required for quality repairs that are located in the Nissan technical publications website. While examining the technical manuals, the student will become familiar with the unique repair considerations that are required by Nissan. In addition, vehicle specific repair considerations are examined for the newly redesigned Titan XD, Armada, LEAF, and GT-R.

Nissan has issued several position statements that must be followed when performing collision repairs. These are designed to ensure Nissan systems operate as designed when the vehicle goes back out on the road. Throughout the course, each position statement is explained as it relates to specific repairs.

Course Content

Module 1

Introduces the student to the Nissan vehicles that make up the 2016 – 2017 model lineup. Additionally, Safety Shield Technologies and passenger protection features are explained.

Module 2

Discusses the Nissan Collision Repair Network. Here the student will learn the benefits, requirements, and where additional information such as the Nissan position statements can be found. The learner will navigate the Nissan publication website and examine the collision repair considerations associated with all Nissan vehicles to include welding, frame construction, sectioning, and pre- and post-scan recommendations.

Module 3

In this module the student will be introduced to vehicle repair considerations that are specific to the 2017 Titan XD, Armada, LEAF, and GT-R.

Module 4

Provides a brief explanation of Nissan hybrid vehicle repair considerations.
